The following information is provided to assist you as you prepare for **mkc** 2009. Please read all details carefully.

MOUNTAIN CAMP, KEDUMBA HOUSE AND CMS CENTRE

- Mountain Camp is located in the Convention Centre at the corner of Cliff Drive and Violet Street, Katoomba
- Kedumba House is located just before the Convention Centre on the right hand side of Cliff Drive
- The CMS Centre is located opposite the Convention Centre at the corner of Cliff Drive and Violet Street, Katoomba.

All sites are fully catered. *However, you will need to bring your own sleeping bag (or blankets), sheets, pillowslip, towel, warm clothes and toiletries.* Pillows are provided and all rooms are carpeted and heated. *(CMS Centre will include blankets for all rooms, and quilts for ensuites.)* **Your accommodation will be available for occupancy from 6.00pm on the Friday of your convention weekend.** Your Site Host/s will allocate rooms and look after all aspects of your stay. Please give them your full co-operation so that the weekend runs smoothly for everyone.

CAMPING AREA

The Camping Area is located on the Convention grounds – access off Laurel Street, Katoomba. If you requested a powered site, your preference has been noted. Allocation of powered sites is in order of booking. **The Camping Area will be open from 3.00pm on the Friday of your convention weekend to allow you time to “peg in” or “plug in”.** The Camping Area Site Host/s will allocate you space and oversee all aspects of your stay. Please give them your full co-operation so that the weekend runs smoothly for everyone.

DUTIES

Everyone will need to help with rostered duties during the weekend. This assistance allows us to keep the costs down.

FEES AND CANCELLATIONS

If, for some reason, you need to cancel your booking or reduce your numbers booked, please contact the **kcc** Office **as soon as possible** so we can try to find a replacement booking/s.

Cancellations must be advised in writing to the **kcc** Office no later than **Wednesday, 10 December 2008**. All accommodation cancellations attract a \$20.00 per person administration fee. The remaining portion is only refunded if the accommodation is re-let. **After Wednesday, 10 December 2008**, accommodation fees are not refundable (in part or in full).

Please note that NO camping accommodation cancellations are refundable (in part or in full).

***Group Leaders and/or Organisers:
Please ensure ALL members of your group
are aware of the following information.***

SITE HOST/S

Your Site Host/s will be on-site when you arrive to show you where you'll be sleeping. Site Host/s are also responsible for the smooth running of the accommodation site over the weekend. Please give them your full co-operation.

SUPERVISION

People under 16 years of age **MUST HAVE A GROUP LEADER** or a **RESPONSIBLE ADULT** supervise them. The Convention does not provide supervision or accept responsibility for the supervision of young people.

"CURFEW"

So that everyone at your accommodation site can get adequate sleep and be reasonably "fresh" in the morning to hear the great talks, please be considerate of others, especially after 11.00pm.

MUSIC, NOISE, ETC

Please do not play music before 8.00am or after 9.00pm. In between times, remember that not everyone shares your taste in music, so keep any music or noise to a minimum so as not to disturb others around you.

FIRE SAFETY

Group Leaders are responsible for keeping track of **ALL MEMBERS** of their group **AT ALL TIMES**, particularly in the event of a bushfire emergency.

CAMPERS

Open fires are not permitted in the Camping Area. Cooking must be done on a gas stove or at the BBQ area provided. At all times, please ensure that there is a minimum of 5 metres of cleared space around a BBQ or gas stove. All trenches and holes around your tent/van site must be filled in before you leave the site. Please use the Camping Area gates rather than accessing the Camping Area through the fences.

OTHER MATTERS

To make sure meals run smoothly, you may be asked to help with a meal/orderlies duty.

Alcohol is not permitted on kcc property.
